

CASWELL COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION MINUTES
Joint Meeting with Board of Caswell County Commissioners
May 3, 2021

The Caswell County Board of Education met in a joint meeting with The Caswell County Board of Commissioners on Monday, May 3, 2021 at 11:00 a.m. The meeting was held at the Caswell County Co-op Building located on the Town Square in Yanceyville, NC. The following members of the Caswell County Board of Commissioners present: Chairman David Owen, Vice Chair Jeremiah Jefferies, William Carter, John Dickerson, Nathaniel Hall, Rick McVey, and Steve Oestreicher and Bryan Miller, County Manager. The Caswell County Schools Board of Education present: Chairman Wayne Owen, Vice Chair Gladys Garland, Donna Hudson, Tracy Stanley (virtually), Vennie Beggarly, Mel Battle, and Trudy Blackwell. Others included Superintendent Dr. Sandra Carter and Finance Director Amy Chandler and Assistant Superintendent Andrew Tyrrell. Connie Kimrey recorded the minutes for the Board of Education. (*Note: The meeting was also held via Zoom.*)

I. A. CALL TO ORDER

The Board of Education meeting was called to order by Chairman Wayne Owen at 11:00 a.m. (The Commissioners had recessed from their 9:00 a.m. meeting to meet with the Board of Education at 11:00 a.m.) Commissioner Chairman David Owen called the Board of Commissioners meeting back to order and welcomed the Board of Education to the meeting. Chairman David Owen reminded everyone that the need today was to focus on possibilities of what we can do for our students and that was the common thread for both boards as we focus on the presentation.

Dr. Carter reviewed and shared information on the following:

- County Appropriation Funding Request Fiscal Year 2021-2022
- CCS Drilldown of Local (Caswell County) Funding for Years 2019-2020 & 2020-2021 (*thru March 31, 2021*)
- Covid Relief Funds
- CCS Per Pupil Allocation and Per Pupil Expenditures for School Year 2019-2020

A copy of the PowerPoint presentation shared with Board of Commissioners on Feb. 22, 2021 joint meeting was included in the packets

Questions asked from the Commissioners included if the teacher supplement request that was included in the Esser funding is received would the Board of Education continue to include it in their budget request. Dr. Carter shared that it was included in both requests as neither has been approved. If it is received from Esser, we would not expect it from the commissioners during those years. The request for Esser funding for teacher supplements is for three years. Dr. Carter shared that we need a commitment to offer to our teachers supplements for multiple years and noted the disadvantage to our county at recruitment fairs when other districts offer supplements.
