

Caswell County Schools Internet Use Agreement

Purpose of Internet Access

In order to support the curriculum and the informational needs of all students, the Caswell County School system provides a wide variety of materials representing a broad range of opinions and ideas presented in many formats. In keeping with this goal, the district provides Internet access to students (fourth grade and above).

Responsibilities of the User (acceptable and unacceptable conduct)

When you use the school network and the Internet, you must:

- use it for educational purposes
- use polite language
- keep your password private
- use information and equipment in a responsible manner

When you use the school network and the Internet, you must not:

- use it for non-educational purposes or to access material that is inappropriate in the school setting
- swear or use vulgar, defamatory, or harassing language
- engage in illegal activities
- share your password with others
- use it for commercial gain or profit
- give out personal information such as a home address or phone number
- upload or download copyrighted software
- intentional harm or destroy data or equipment
- attempt of gain access to data or equipment that is not rightfully yours to access
- use it to initiate or respond to chain letters

Consequences of Unacceptable Conduct

The use of the network is a privilege. Inappropriate use will result in losing the privilege and, perhaps, other disciplinary action as appropriate in your school's code of conduct.
